

## Learner's Fee Protection Policy

## 1. Purpose

In order to protect the prepaid fee made by the learners, Elite Education Vocational Institute (EEVI) has this policy in place.

## 2. Scope

This policy applies to all students of EEVI.

## 3. Principles

- 3.1. When a prospective or current learner prepay fees in excess of a total of \$1500 (being the threshold prepaid fee amount), this fee will be kept in trust account and cannot be used until the term starts.
- 3.2. If EEVI is unable to provide services for which the learner has prepaid, the learner will be either
  - a) placed into an equivalent course such that:
    - the new location is suitable to the learner; and
    - the learner receives the full services for which they have prepaid at no additional cost to the learner; or
  - b) be paid a refund of any prepaid fees for services yet to be delivered above the threshold prepaid fee amount.
- 3.3. EEVI has joined the Tuition Protection Service (TPS) framework, if EEVI is unable to fulfil its obligations to complete a course. The TPS framework will facilitates the placement of students in the first instance, and where this is not possible, provides a refund of unexpended tuition fees (i.e. tuition the student has paid for but has not been delivered by the provider).
